Subject	Action Taken
<b>Subject-1: Welcome of New Principal</b>	The new principal was formally welcomed, and the IQAC composition was updated to reflect the changes. The new members were oriented on their roles and responsibilities.
<b>Subject-2: Review of Teaching, Learning, and Evaluation Process, Academic Calendar, Collaborative Activities, and Research Proposals to Funding Agencies</b>	Collaborative activities were organized under existing MoUs. The Academic Committee ensured that the syllabus was completed on time. Faculty members were informed about funding opportunities, and several research proposals were submitted to different agencies.
<b>Subject-3: Introduction of Certificate and Value-Added Courses</b>	09 New certificate and value-added courses were introduced as per the IQAC's direction. These courses were designed and launched, and student enrollment commenced, contributing to their holistic development.

Subject	Action Taken
<b>Subject-1: Organization of Seminar, Workshops, Conferences</b>	The Departments of Commerce and Geography successfully organized the ICSSR-sponsored seminars and conferences. The proceedings were documented and published with an ISBN number, ensuring a wider dissemination of the academic contributions.

Subject	Action Taken
<b>Subject-1: Planning of Next Academic Year</b>	Committees were established to oversee the implementation of NEP-2020 and other academic activities. Student representatives were included in these committees to ensure their involvement and input.
<b>Subject-2: Review of Academic Progress (Syllabus and Practical Examination)</b>	The Examination Committee provided a detailed review of Sem-II exams, and reports on syllabus completion and practicals were prepared and submitted.
<b>Subject-3: Scholarship to the Students</b>	The scholarships were awarded to 13 students recognizing their exceptional achievements in various fields. The recipients were notified, and the scholarships were disbursed.
<b>Subject-4: Alumni Association</b>	Alumni registration on the central portal was completed, and several alumni lectures were organized for current students to share their experiences and knowledge.
<b>Subject-5: Academic and Administrative Audit, Energy and Green Audit</b>	The college arranged for the Academic and Administrative Audit (AAA) as well as energy and green audits. Approved agencies conducted the audits, and the reports were reviewed for necessary actions.
<b>Subject-6: Placement of the Campus</b>	Placement drives were successfully organized by the Training and Placement Cell. Several companies participated, leading to numerous placements for UG and PG students.
