SUMMARY REPORT OF ACADEMIC COMMITTEE ACADEMIC YEAR 2021-22

The academic committee constituted by the college has taken monthly review meeting regarding academic work related to various committees. The committee has prepared academic calendar at the beginning of the academic year 2021-22 under the guidance of Director and Principal. This calendar has helped for the planning of various academic, curricular and extra-curricular activities. The academic work related committees were formed for the smooth conductance of academic work like Time Table Committee, Exam Committee, Research Committee and Academic & Administrative Audit Committee.

The academic committee have prepared theory as well as practical time table with the assistance of Time Table Committee and monitored Teaching Learning processes time to time as per changes required due to Covid-19 Pandemic. The committee has taken care for the completion of teaching of all faculties.

The committee has allotted soft skill development courses, certificate courses for needy students, bridge courses and remedial courses for weaker students to various departments and continuously monitored their progress.

The class teachers were allotted to all UG and PG classes for smooth conductance of various activities for the students. All teachers have completed attendance on a daily basis, teaching plans and teacher daily diary. Our college has successfully implemented work compliance system, learning material distribution like question-answer bank system, syllabus coverage and progress system.

As a part of curriculum, various departments of our college has organized industrial visits, field visits and educational tours for the students to make learning process experiential and more practical. The various departments of the college such as Economics, Commerce and Chemistry have conducted projects for UG and PG students. For conducting the student's research projects, our institute has provided Rs. 30,000/- financial assistance to inculcate research culture and strengthen research activities for the students (Rs. 10,000/- for each stream). Also the chemistry department of our college has organized activities like seminars and power point presentations for the PG students.

The guest lectures, seminars and alumni webinars were also organized by various departments for UG and PG students.

The time tables of theory internal examination as well as practical internal and external examination of UG and PG classes were prepared by examination committee as per university guidelines and have been successfully implemented smoothly as per scheduled.

The committee have prepared format for Internal Academic & Administrative Audit for all the academic departments. Using this format the Internal Academic & Administrative Audit of last academic year 2020-21 was completed on 2nd March 2022 while the academic year 2021-22 was completed on 25-26th November 2022.

The committee has given time to time inputs for the academic excellence of the students and our all academic work related committees; teachers have successfully completed the academic work for the year 2021-22.
