1.Scope and Importance of Department -

The Department of Economics was established in July 1997, along with the beginning of the college. As a core discipline of great significance, the department strives to maximize its efforts in creating awareness among students about various national and international issues.

Introduction of the Department-

The subject of Economics was introduced as a compulsory subject for the Faculty of Commerce in 1997 and as an optional subject for the Faculty of Arts in the same year. The Department of Economics has been offering Economics as a special subject since July 1998. The department offers B.A. courses in Economics. Currently, there are two faculty members in the Department of Economics. The faculty members are actively engaged in teaching, consultancy, and research activities. At present, 33 students are pursuing their studies with Economics as a special subject.

The teachers provide academic and personal counselling to students preparing for careers in banking, insurance, investment analysis, the service sector, and more. The departmental staff is also involved in various courses and activities such as the Research Methodology Course, Training Program on Employability Skills, Socio-Economic Surveys, Certificate Courses in GST, and Bridge Courses.
