Introduction of Department

The **Department of Politics** was established in 1997 at the general level and in 2000-01 at the special level. The department offers a **B.A. Degree in Politics**, which has seen an increasing demand from students in recent years. To broaden students' perspectives, the department organizes various academic and extracurricular activities, including **seminars, workshops, and study tours**. Additionally, the department hosts an **Expert Lecture Series** every year as part of the **Quality Improvement Program** of the University of Pune.

The department is staffed with two highly qualified faculty members. It is equipped with sufficient furniture, computers, and other necessary facilities. The department operates from a

dedicated cabin on the second floor of the Social Science Department building. It also boasts an extensive collection of **reference books, journals, and teaching aids** such as **maps, charts, and CDs**.

To enhance the quality of education, the department regularly organizes seminars and lecture series. Faculty members also engage in research activities, with one faculty member having published **12 research papers** and attended **7 workshops** over the last three years.
