

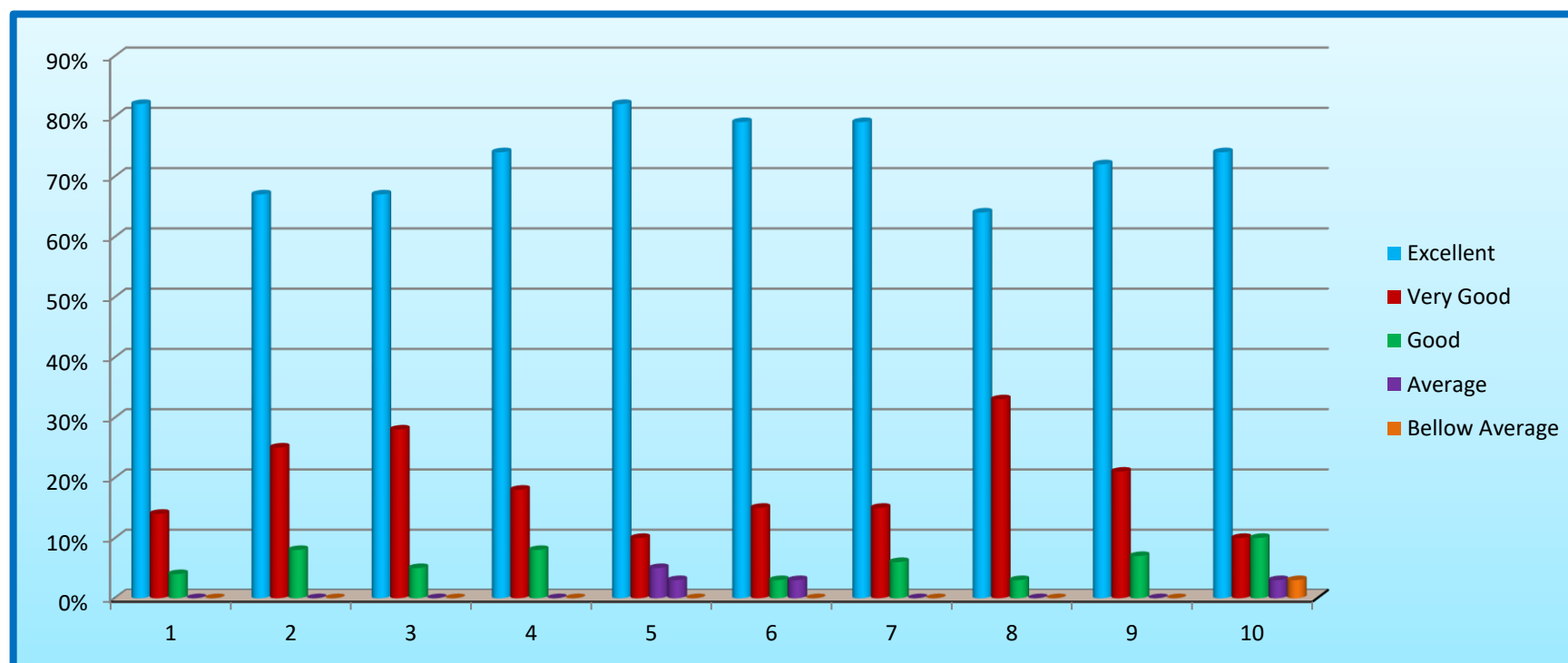

4. 82% teachers provide their positive opinion as a excellent, very good and good for Library facilities.



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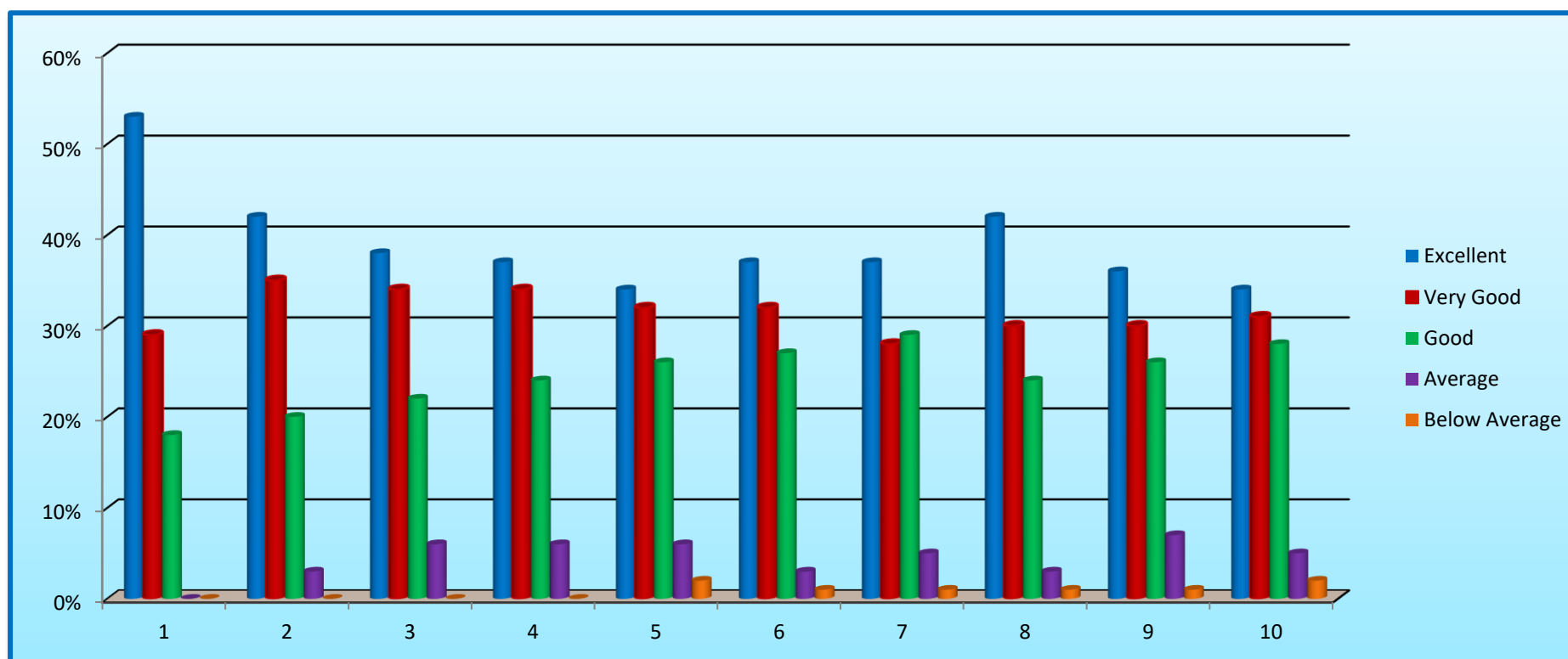

5. According to the feedback 42% students said that the academic support and guidance provided by the college is Excellent while 54% remarked it as good.



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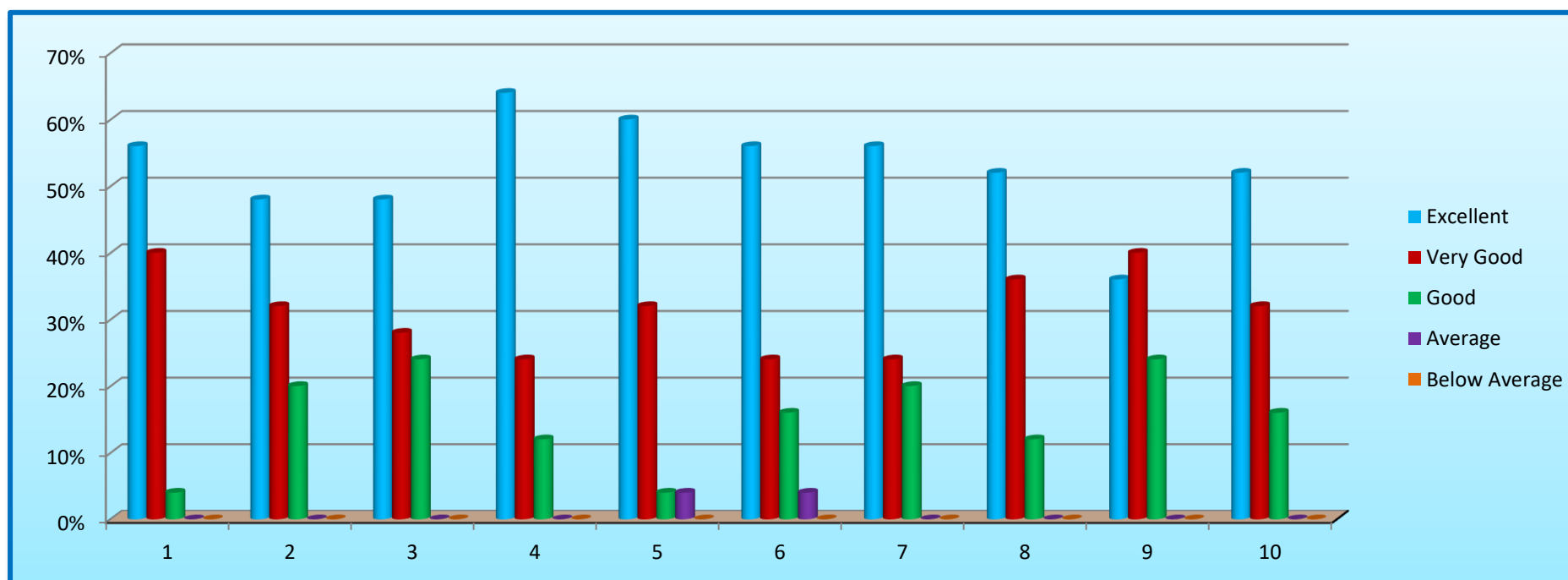

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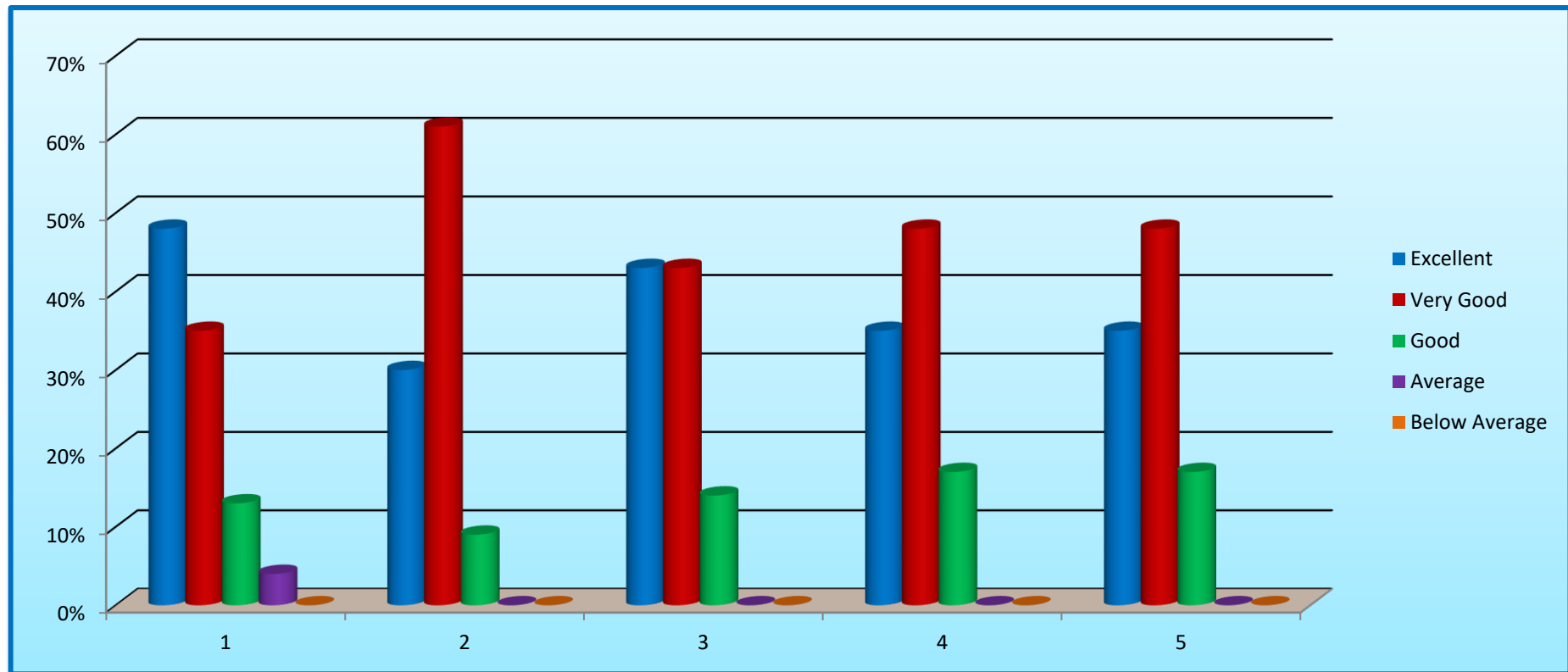

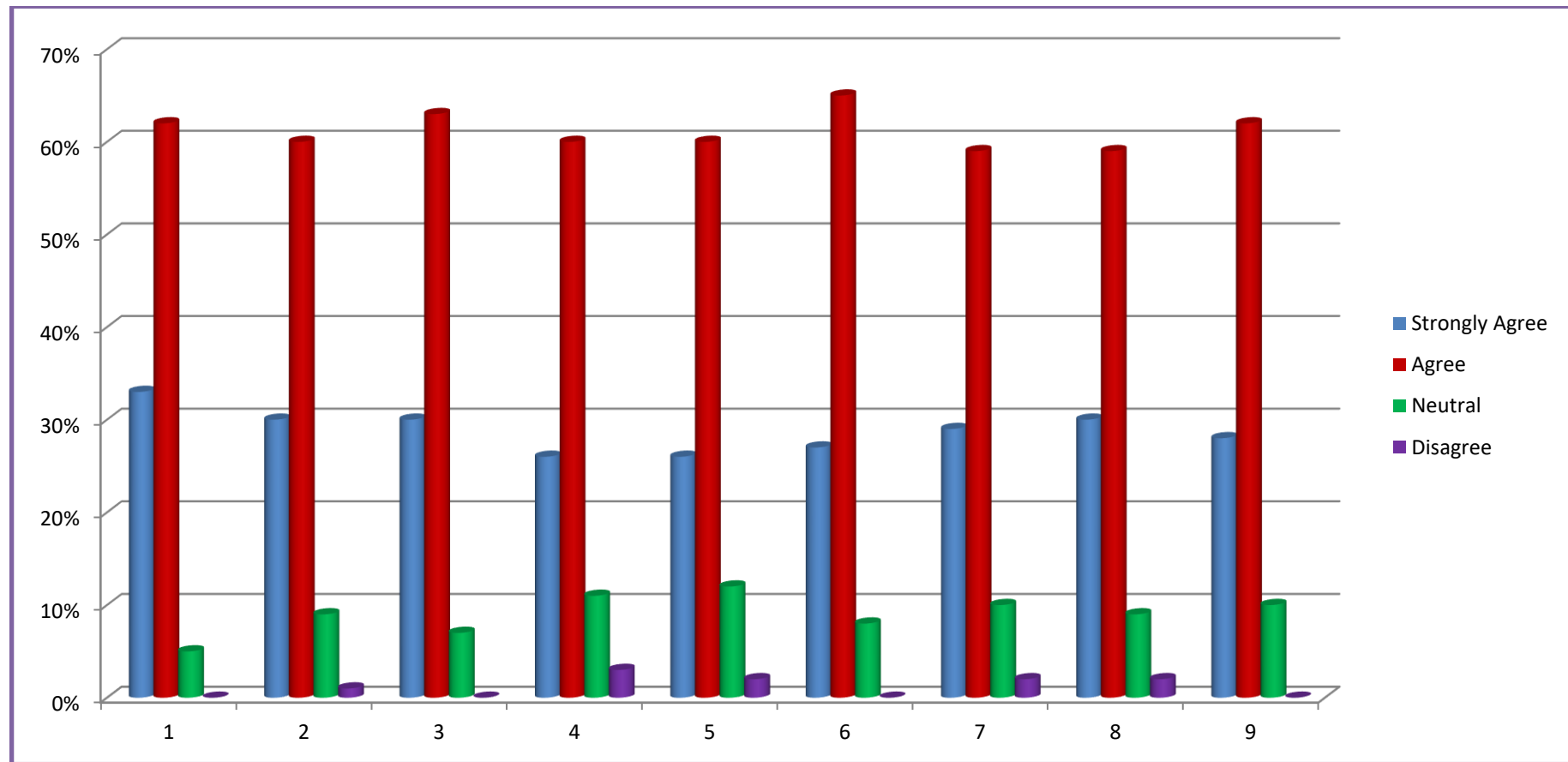

4. Only 1% students are disagree regarding their syllabus.


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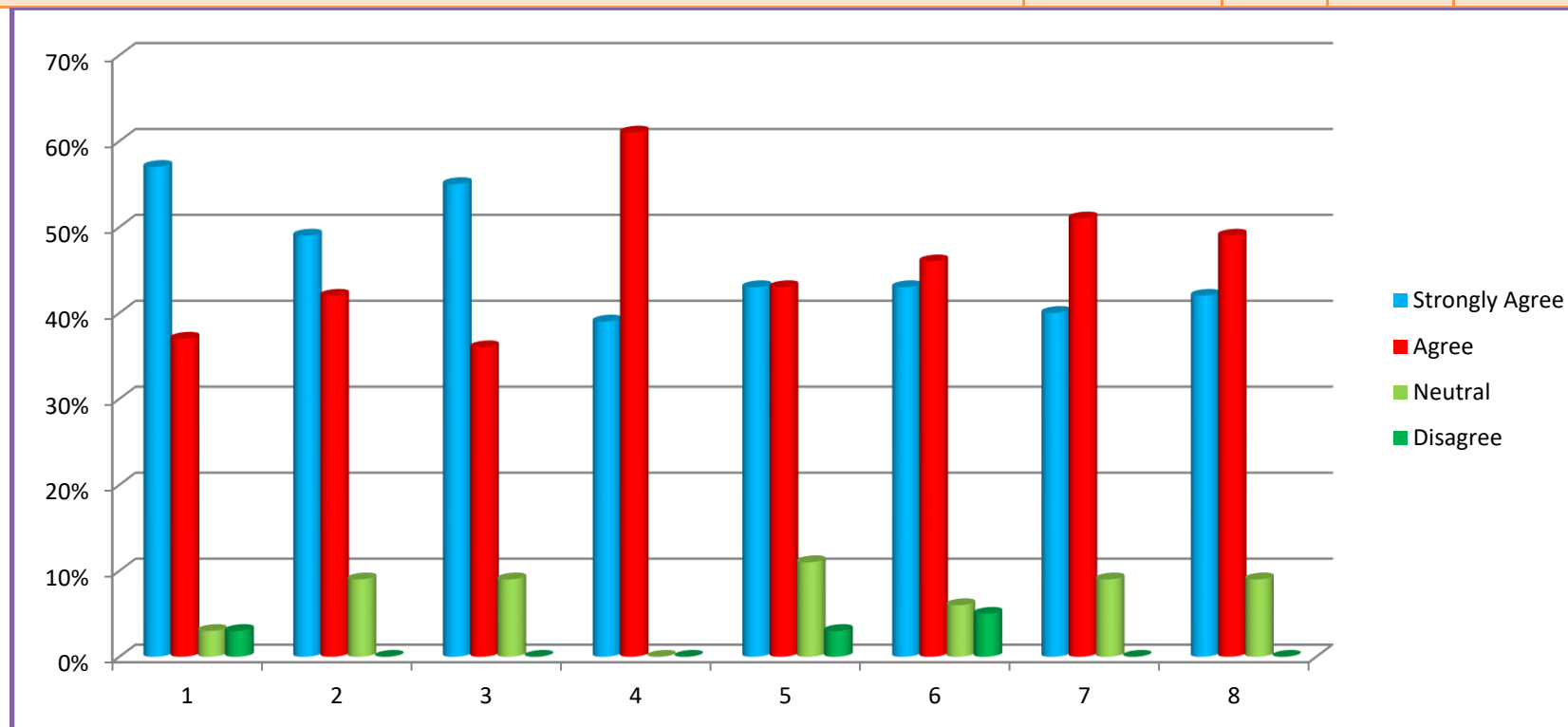



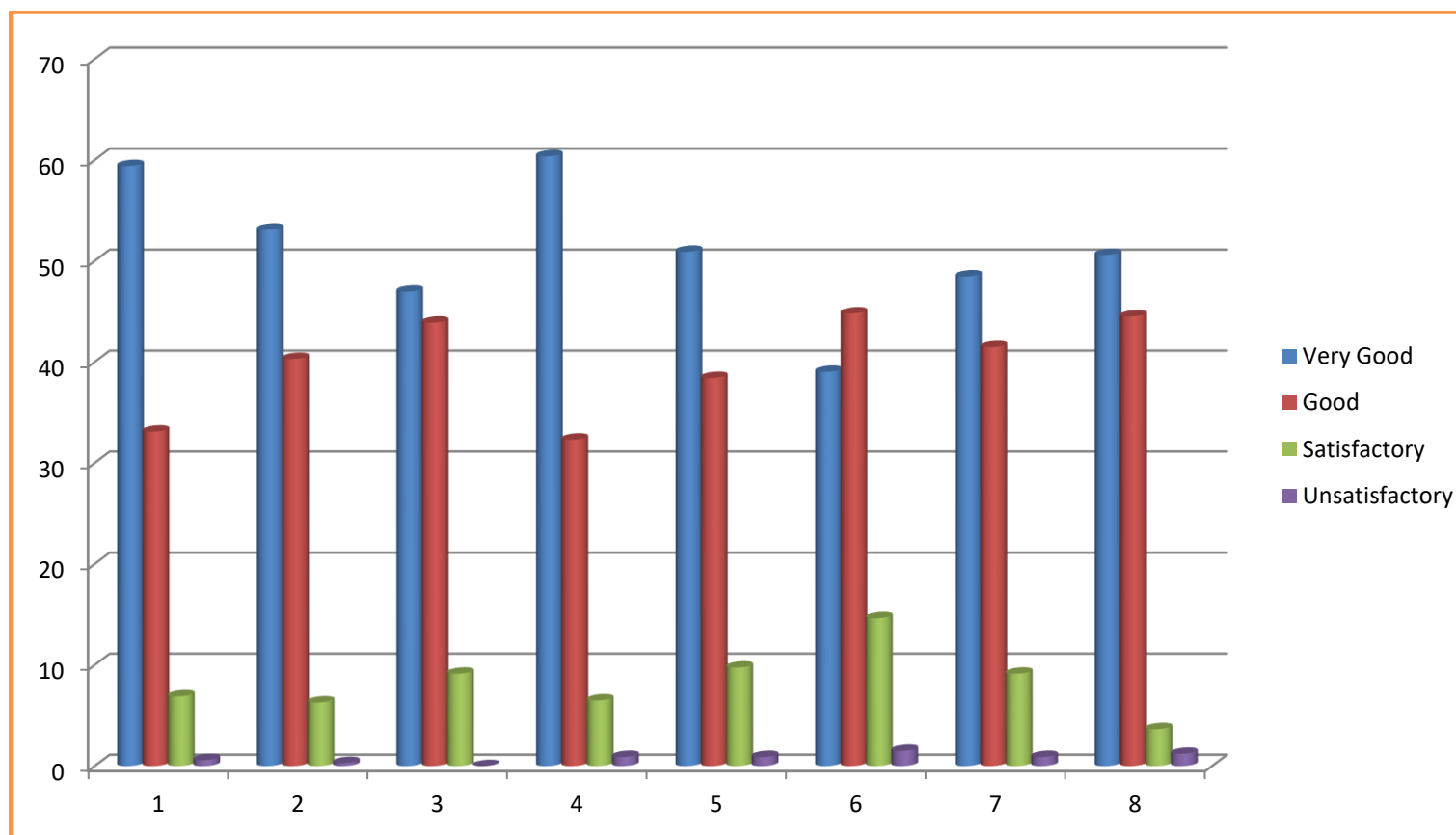

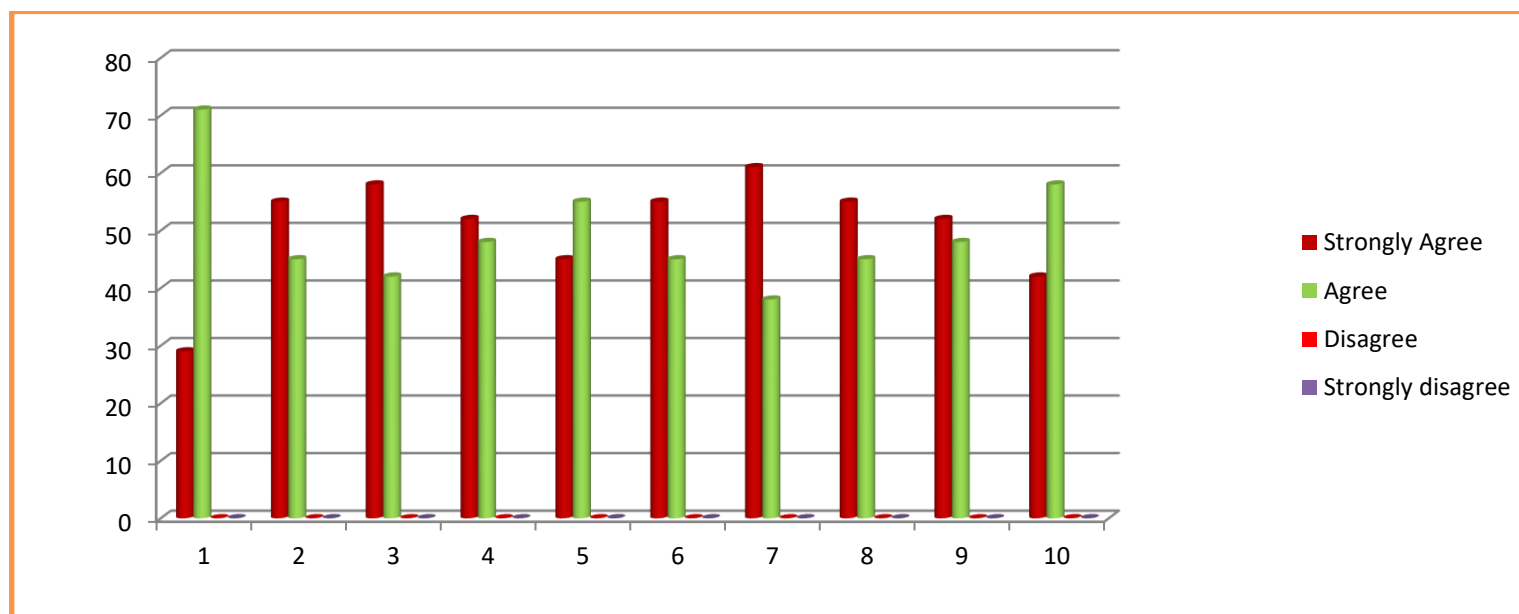

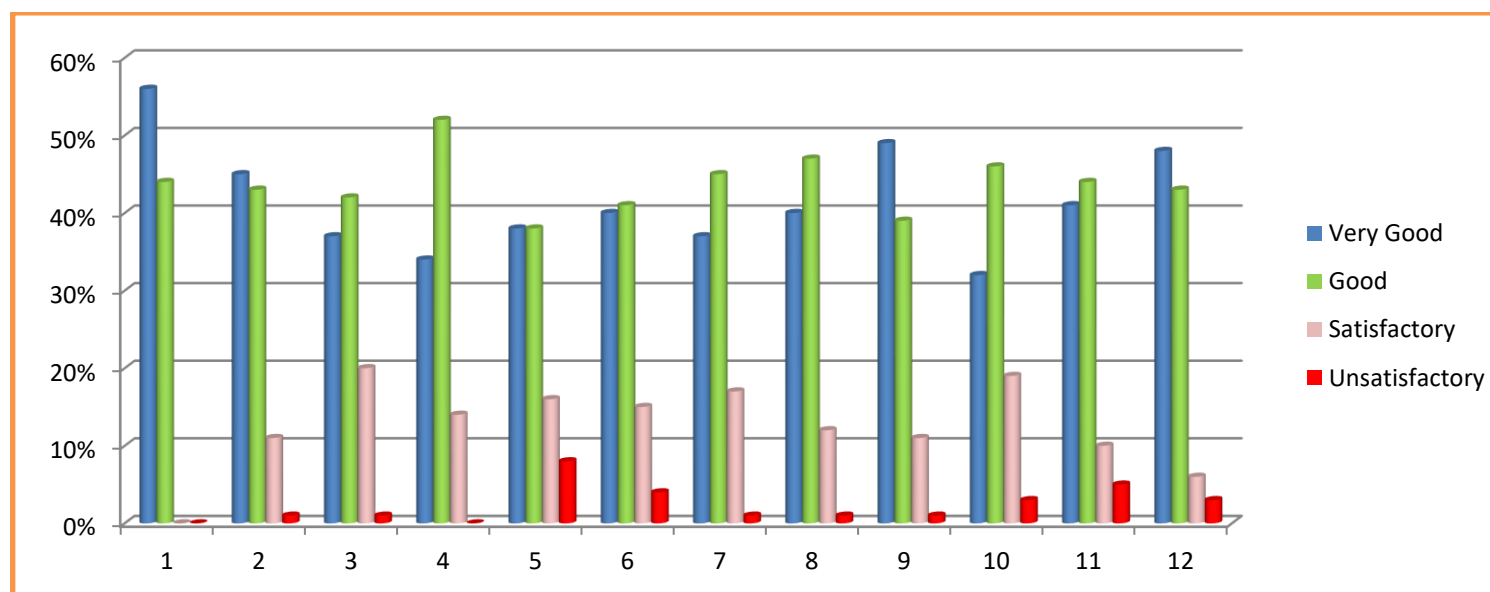

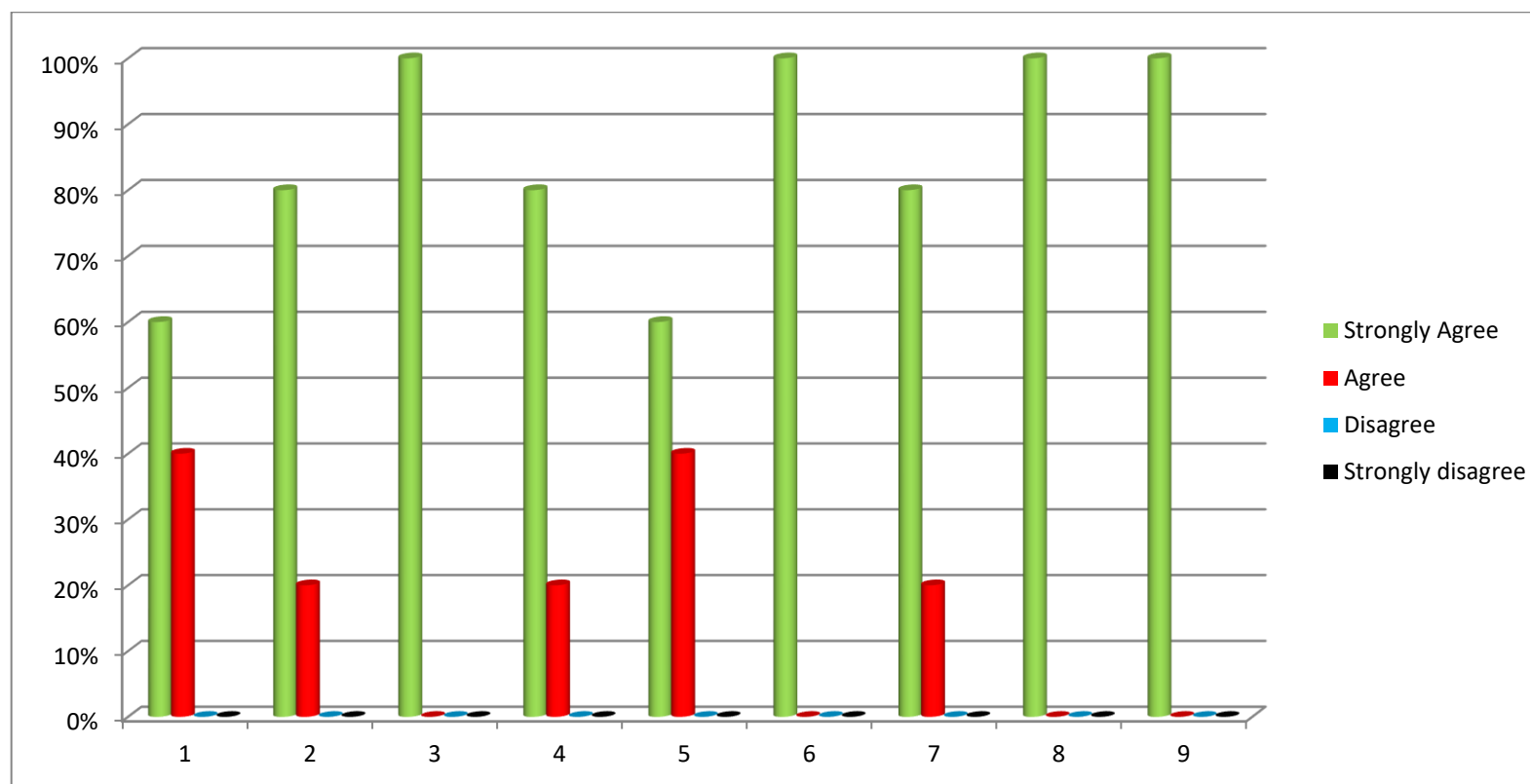

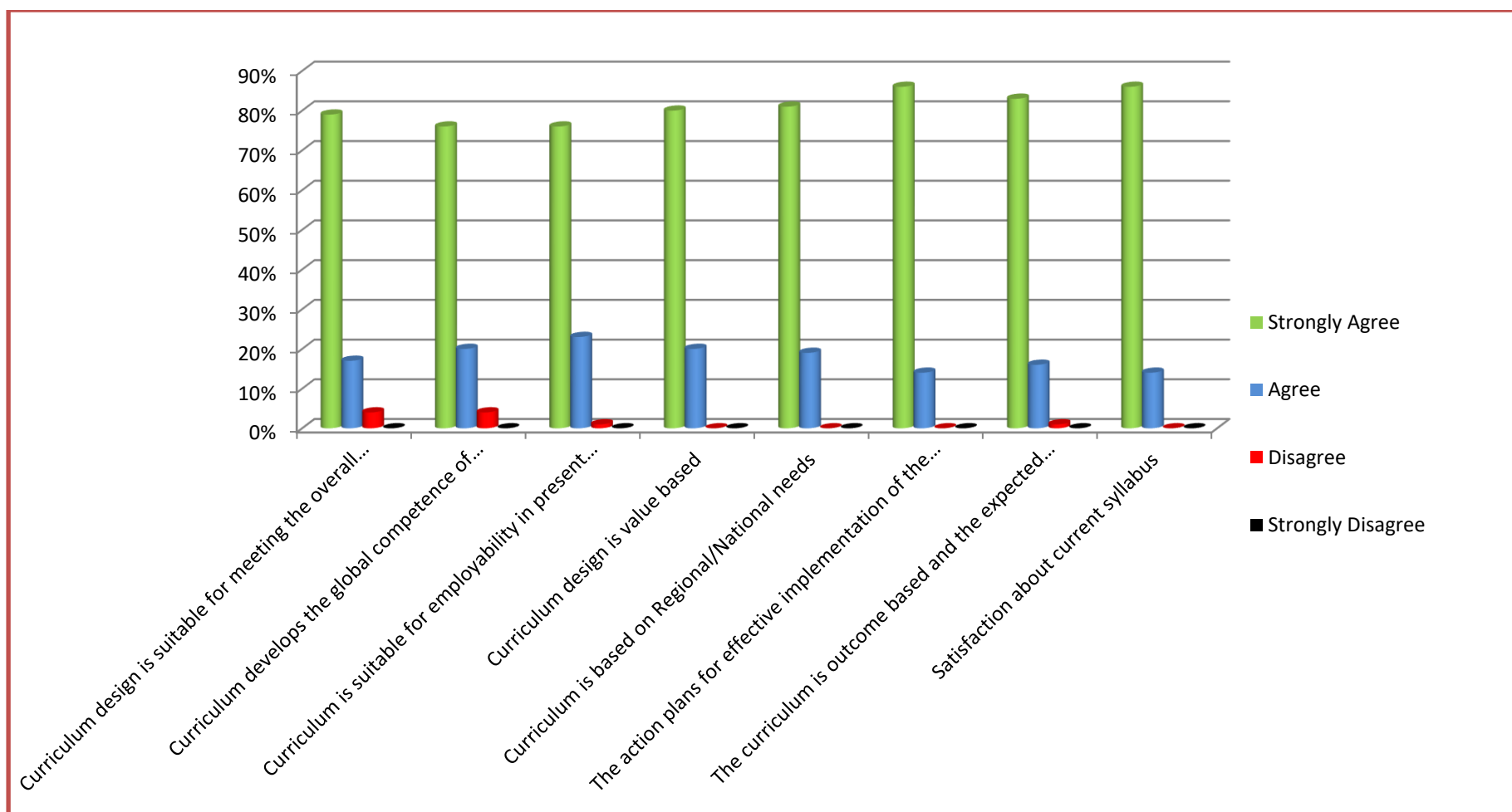




**Student Feedback on Curriculum

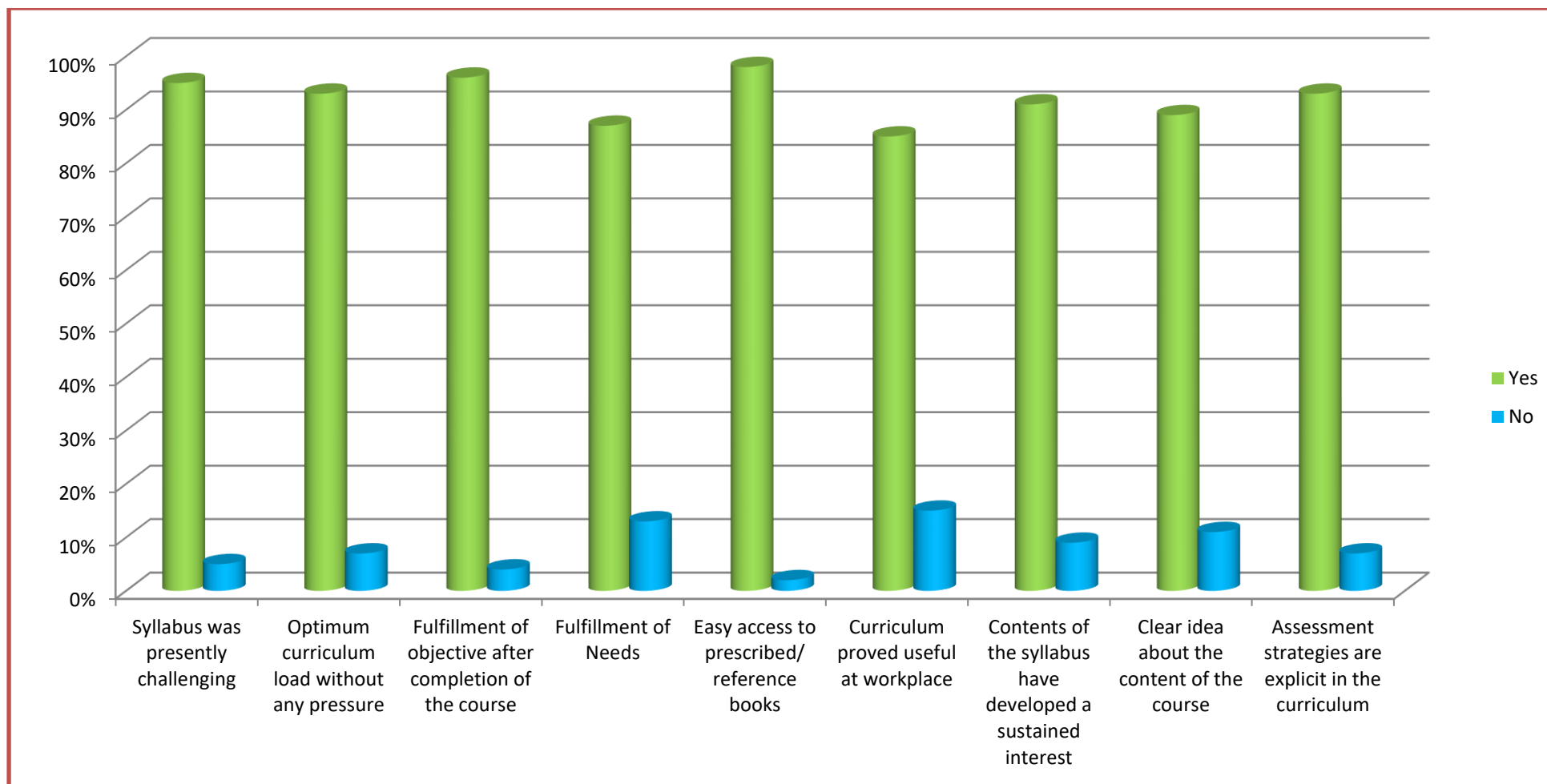

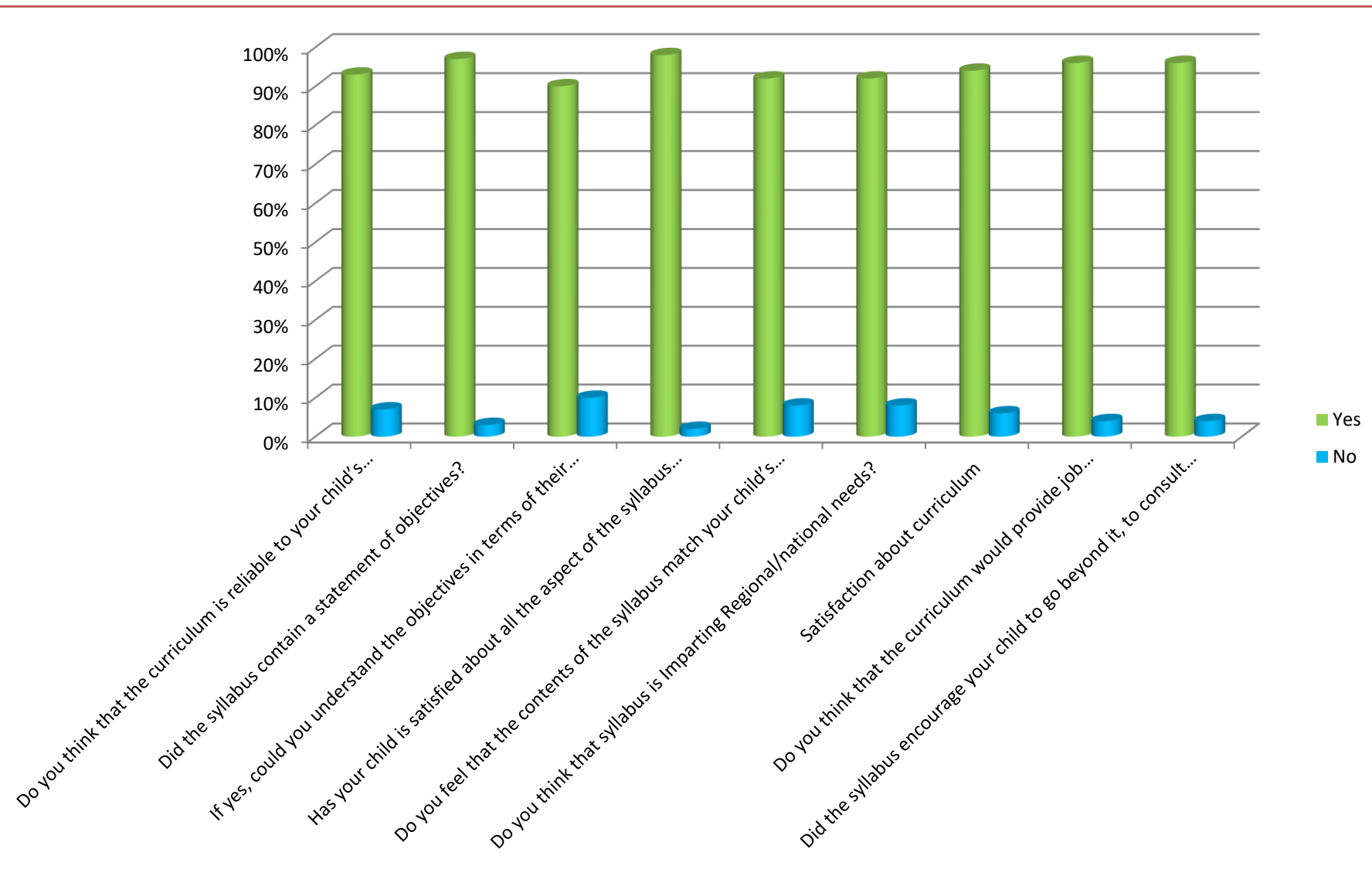






Student Feedback on Teachers- Graphical Representation

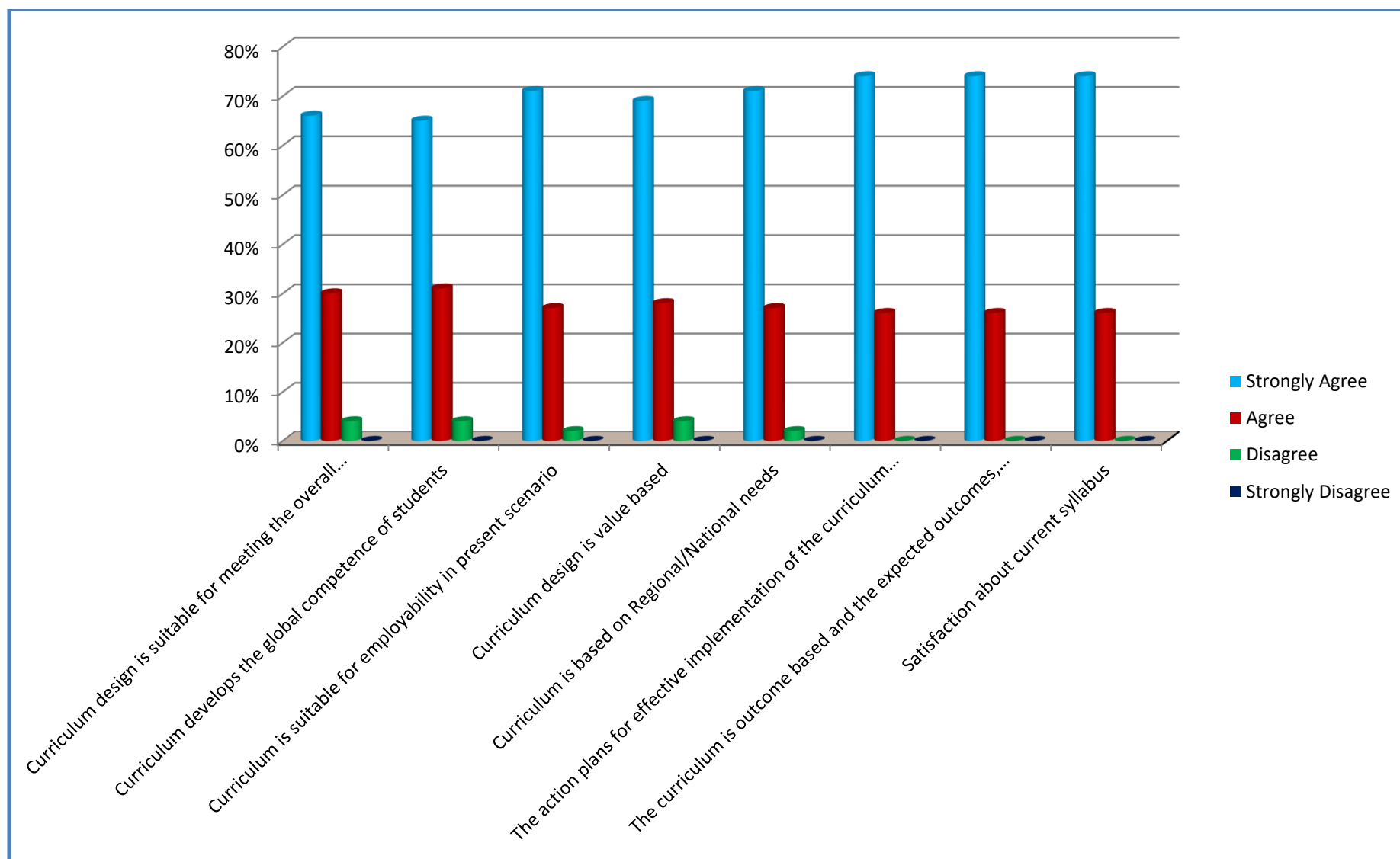

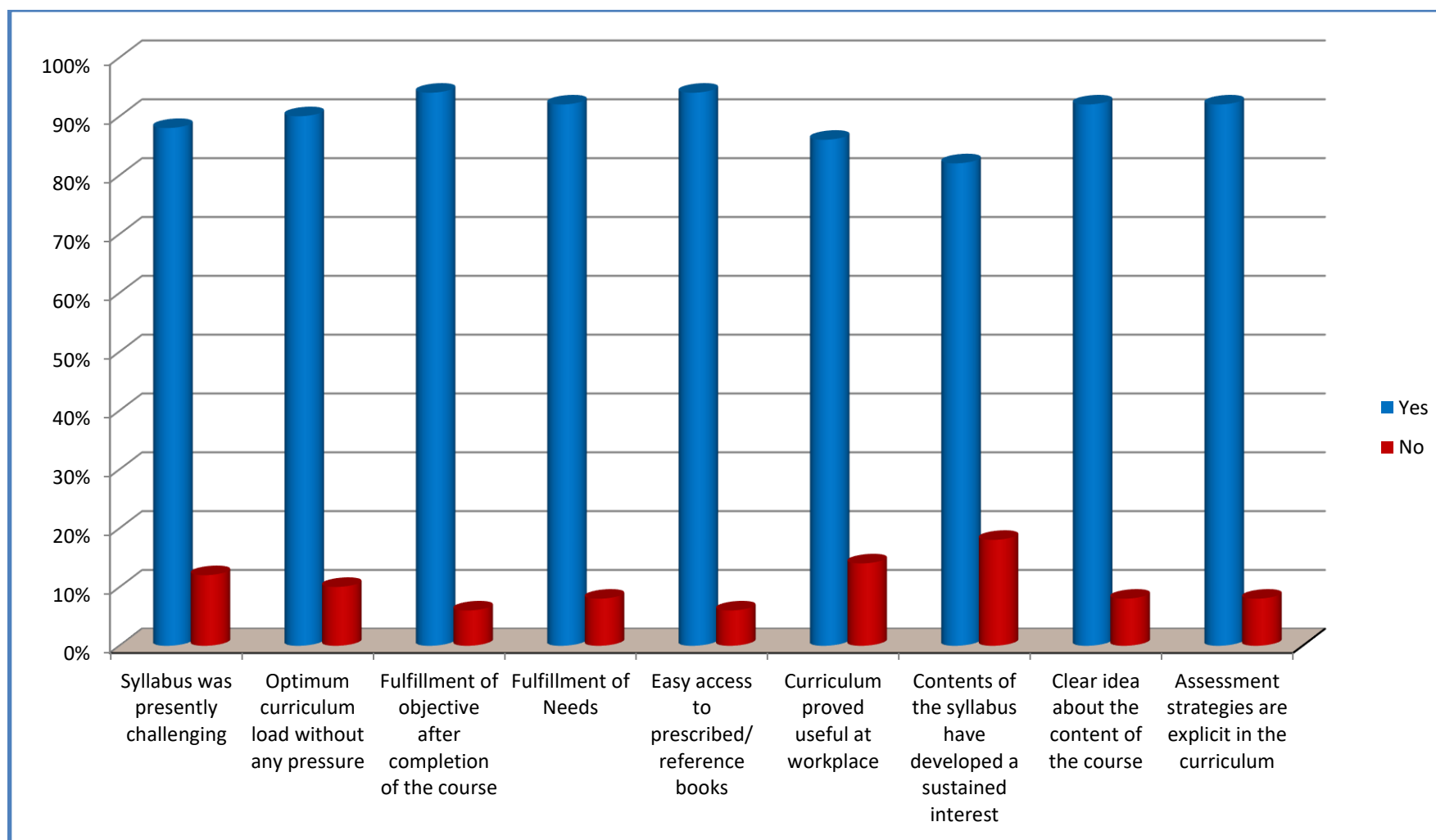

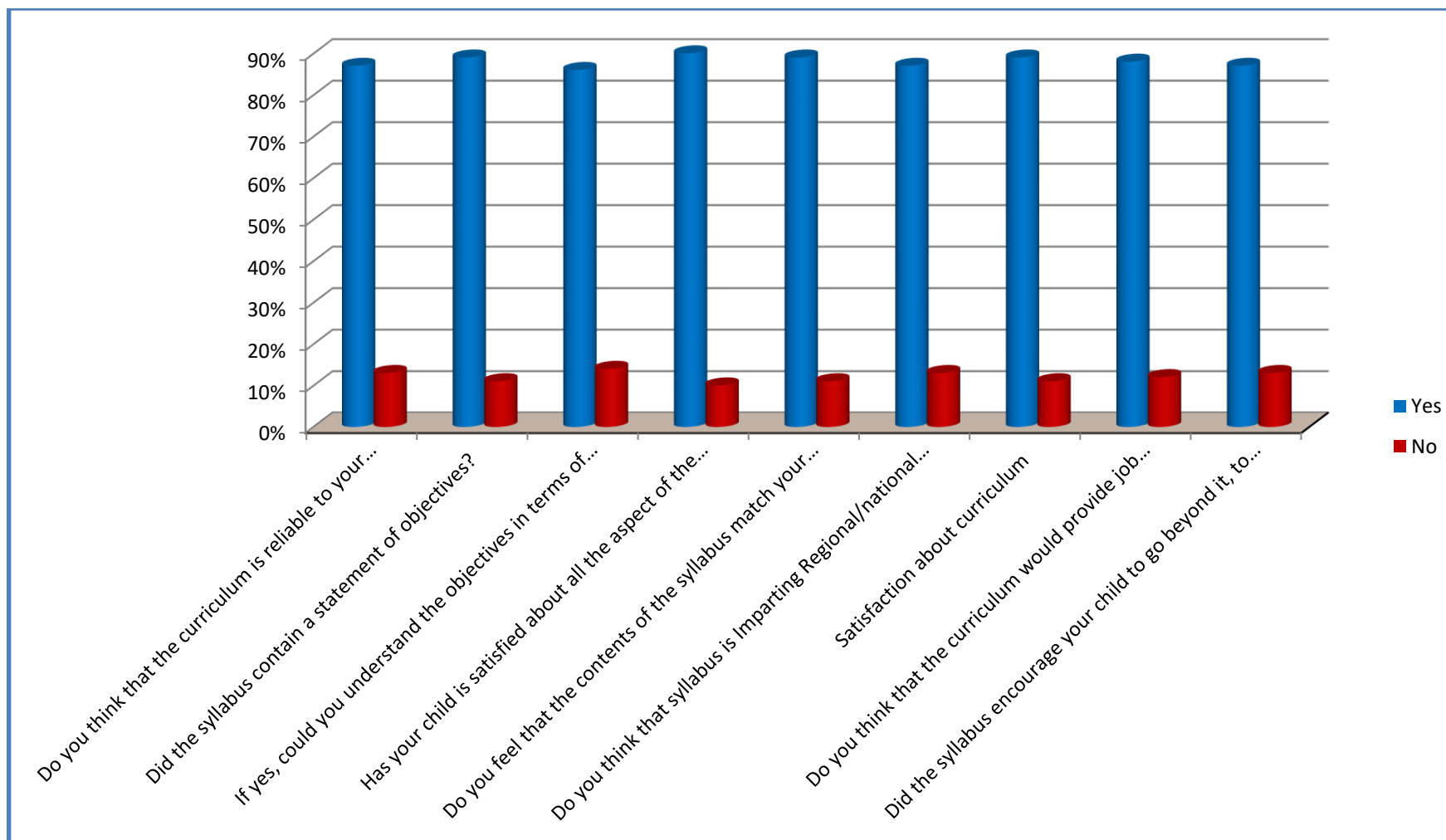

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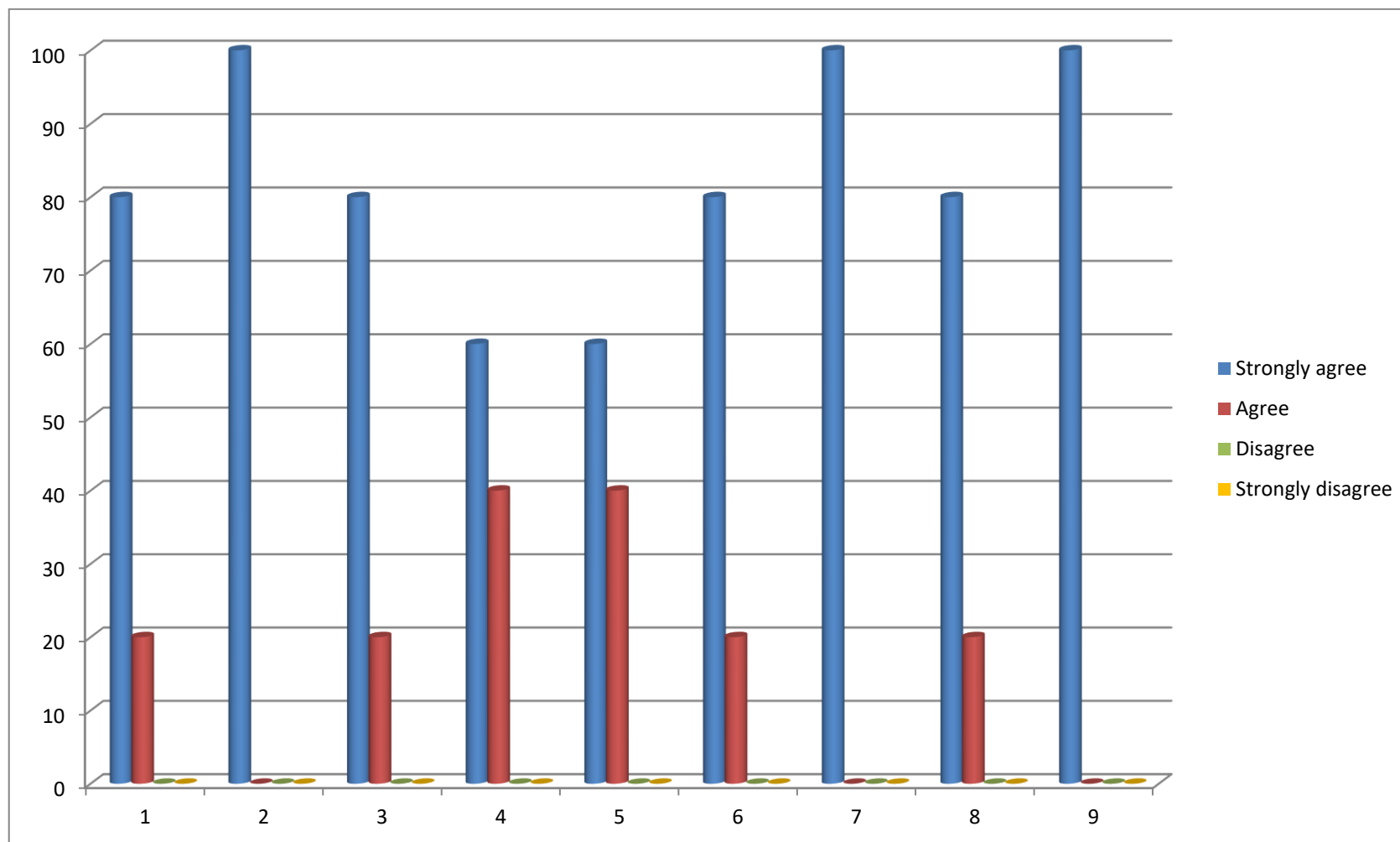
