Policy of Quality Assurance Strategies

Introduction:

IQAC will create internal awareness on quality issues and also establish credibility to the external quality evaluation.

Objectives:

Composition of the IOAC

The IQAC committee is formed as per the guidelines of NAAC, it is being decided that NAAC committee is to be reformed and some new members as external expert and Administrative staff and I/C Principal were included. With reference to the IQAC meeting, it was decided to redesign IQAC by change of the member that is newly appointed Principal Prof. (Dr.) S. S. Gholap and Dr. Varsha S. Patil as a teacher representative instead of Dr. Madhavi S. Patgaonkar due to retirement.

IQAC constituted in institution under the Chairmanship of the Head of the institution with heads of important academic and administrative units and a few teachers and a few distinguished education is and representatives of local management and stakeholders. IQAC helps the institutions in planning and monitoring. IQAC also gives stakeholders or beneficiaries across-sectional participation in the institution's quality enhancement activities.

The IQAC meet at least three times in every quarter. The quorum for the meeting shall be two-third of the total number of members. The agenda, minutes and Action Taken Reports are to be documented with official signatures and maintained electronically. It is necessary for the members of the IQAC to shoulder the responsibilities of generating and promoting awareness in the institution and to devote time for working out the procedural details. While selecting these members several precautions need to be taken. A few of them are listedbelow:



Mobilization of Funds and Optimal Utilization of Resources

Introduction:

The institute is self-confident to grow by mobilizing requisite funds and optimal use of resources. Since it is a private aided college, the main sources of funds are students' fees and grant in aid from government.

Objectives:

- 1. To mobilize the funds properly.
- 2. To optimize the utilization of resources

Policy:

- The funds can be generated through salary grants, developmental grants and grants received for NSS, NCC, student welfare activities, seminars, conferences, workshops and research activities.
- 2. Funds can be generated from donations from alumni and sale of agricultural produce.
- **3.** Funds can also be generated through revenue collected from tuition fees, developmental fees, hostel fees, sale of fruits and saplings, breakage, rent of staff quarters etc.
- **4.** Various UGC grants (CPE, CE, and Research and infrastructure development), DST-FIST and DBT grants can be other sources.
- 5. The strategies for resource mobilization and optimal utilization of resources should be as, the HoDs, committee chairmen should be asked to submit their annual financial requirements. Accordingly, the principal should prepare the annual budget of the institution considering the income and expenditure.
- **6.** The principal should forward the prepared budget for its sanction to the governing body of the institution.
- 7. All the key financial transactions should be scrutinized and verified by the governing body under the heads viz. Salary to visiting staff, Internet charges, General repairs and maintenance, Electricity maintenance charges, computer consumables, Postage and courier,

Stationary and expenses on Student placement/Academic and sports prizes, Newspapers and periodicals, laboratory consumables and gas, Library books, Computer equipments, Staff welfare schemes non-recurring expenses and other expenses

- **8.** Institute should stick on the deployment of budget approved for academic and administrative expenses by the management.
- **9.** The purchase process is initiated after getting the final approval of the budget from the governing body.
- **10.** The quotations should be called and with the consent of respective HoDs, the purchase orders may place by the purchase department of SSRI after negotiations.
- **11.** The payment should be released after delivery of the respective goods as per the terms and conditions placed in the purchase order.
- **12.** Transparency should be maintained in all the financial transactions through vouchers and bills. The payment should be passed after checking and verification of items. All the party payments should be made through bank.
- **13.** The concerned department should ensure that, the received material is as per the specifications/terms and conditions mentioned in the purchase order.
- **14.** The purchase procedure for the grants received from the various funding agencies for research is monitored by the research committee.
- **15.** A system of internal and external financial audit should be in place.

INTERNAL EXAMINATION POLICY

Continuous Internal Assessment:

The institution follows a Continuous Internal Evaluation System. The main objective of it is to evaluate student learning at regular intervals by conducting Class Tests, Internal / Term End Examinations, Classroom Assessment, Projects and Practical's.

Academic performance of students is evaluated both by Continuous Internal Assessment (CIA) and University Examinations. The following is the ratio of marks allotted for CIA and University Examinations.

Marks in each course are assessed by Class Tests, Internal/Term End Examinations, Assignments/ Seminars and Attendance in respect of theory courses and Lab involvement.

Attendance in all the tests is compulsory.

The Class Test is conducted at department level where as Internal /Term End Exam is at institute level The Timetable of Internal /Term End Exam is duly prepared and circulated among the students in advance.

To ensure transparency of the evaluation process, the marks allotted are displayed on the Department Notice Board. Internal Marks are calculated on the basis of the marks secured in the Class Tests, Seminars/ Assignments, Classroom performance and Internal Exam.

The candidate has to secure 40% to pass in UG/PG.

The test papers of both theory and practical are distributed to the students after every Class Test.

The Internal Exam papers are preserved in the departments till the completion of the student's course of study.

Precision and transparency in the internal assessment are achieved assessment components by following measures:

1. Communicating the internal assessment components in advance through Academic Calendar, Notice Boards and announcement system.

- 2. Circulating and publishing the internal assessment marks.
- 3. Giving opportunity for the students to approach grievances redressal committees Department, College and University levels.
- 4. Discussing the internal assessment class wise record in Parent Teachers Meeting.

University Examinations:

Examination Grievances Redressal:

There is complete transparency in the internal assessment. Examination planner for internal examination is prepared by College Examination Committee. College Examination Officer (CEO) monitors the schedule of internal examination and internal evaluation process. The student's grievances related to internal examination are solved by College Examination Committee.

Redressal of Grievances at College Level Examinations:

All the Internal Examinations are conducted as per the regulations of SPPU. Transparency is maintained during the examinations.

For any query or grievances regarding the internal examination, the concerned students can approach to respective course-teacher, class teacher or head of the department.

All the college level internal examination related grievances are resolved at the level of course-teacher, class teacher or Head of the department.

Redressal of grievances at University level:

The queries or grievances related to the examination forms, hall ticket correction, results, correction in marks sheets or other certificates etc. are handled by College Examination section.

Applications regarding these are collected from the students and are forwarded to the University. CEO monitors the progress of such cases so that students get their grievance redressed as early aspossible.





Proposal:

To provide necessary skills and knowledge in students to be on par with global educational standards in the fields of science, technology, education, and industry, and to support the government in providing new age education, quality education, and research in India. In line with the National Education Policy 2020, efforts have been made to ensure the holistic development of students by integrating all available capacities.

Following the decision made on 26th August 2022, Dr. Ravikumar Kulkarni, Principal of Mumbai University, was appointed as the chairman of the committee established to provide suggestions and guidelines for implementing the aspects of the National Education Policy 2020 concerning higher education in tribal areas.

A circular was issued on 26th December 2022, instructing to follow the guidelines provided by Dr. Kulkarni regarding the implementation of the National Education Policy in tribal regions, specifically concerning higher education.

In the government decision dated 26th December 2022, the committee chaired by Dr. Kulkarni presented a report on the education of students in tribal regions. This report was submitted to the Government on 11th April 2023 and was presented in a meeting chaired by the Minister of Higher and Technical Education. The government accepted the report and issued directives for the implementation of recommendations made by the committee. The detailed guidelines will be issued soon, which will help in the efficient and comprehensive implementation of the policy for the academic years 2023-24 onwards.

The circular dated 26th December 2022 underlines the importance of following the suggestions provided by the committee chaired by Dr. Kulkarni to ensure that the implementation of the National Education Policy 2020 in tribal areas aligns with the state's educational goals.

Government Decision:

- A committee chaired by Dr. Ravikumar Kulkarni, Principal of Mumbai University, was established to examine the implementation of the National Education Policy 2020 in tribal regions. The committee will also monitor the comprehensive implementation of the policy from the academic year 2023-24 onwards.
- According to the Maharashtra Public University Act, 2016, Article 4 (19), necessary infrastructural changes will be made to implement the National Education Policy 2020 in tribal regions.



Teacher's feedback analysis-Graphical representation







Student Feedback - Graphical Representation




Graphical Representation of Qualified Students in Competitive Examinations
