

Best Practice: I

Title of the Practice: Awareness and Distribution of Medicinal Plants

Aim: To encourage the use of natural remedies and engage the local community in the preservation and promotion of medicinal plants.

Objectives of the Practice:

The primary objectives of implementing the best practice are as follows:

1. To establish the herbal garden in the campus and educate society about the preservation and traditional applications of medicinal plants.
2. To preserve traditional knowledge of herbal medicine and encourage sustainable practices that benefit both people and the environment.
3. It also serves as a resource for students, Farmers, and others to learn how to recognize and protect these significant plants.
4. Popularization of importance and use of medicinal plants in the vicinity of Rahata tehsil.

Context:

The practice of maintaining an herbal garden is essential in preserving and promoting the use of medicinal plants. It serves as a valuable resource for researchers, healthcare professionals, and the villagers interested in herbal remedies. The context for implementing these best practices can vary, including educational institutions, botanical gardens, healthcare facilities and community-based initiatives.

The Practice:

- Institute conducted a survey from April 21-26, 2023, in 5 villages to assess the adoption of medicinal tree plantations by villagers. Inspired by the institution's activities, 45 out of 100 surveyed families had planted medicinal trees, such as Tulsi, Neem, Aloe-vera and Amla, for healthcare purposes. The survey confirms the institution's efforts have promoted sustainable healthcare practices in rural areas.
- Institute had organized “Medicinal Tree Plantation Program” on 17 April 2023 in the village Khadkewake, in which the local community were made aware about the importance of medicinal plants to maintain sustainable health, need of conservation and plantation of medicinal saplings. A

total of 09 students from botany department under the guidance of 04 staff members planted saplings of various medicinal plants.

- Institute conducts awareness campaigning on medicinal plants, particularly related to the conservation and use of the medicinal plants. In this context the institute in collaboration with Student Development Board had organized a Workshop on the conservation, cultivation, and enrichment of Medicinal Plants on the 4th March 2023. Dr. A. S. Wabale and Mr. D. N. Gholap guided students about the conservation and utilization of herbal Plants. Total 94 students were benefitted from the workshop and they awarded by medicinal plants for their home garden. Likewise, institute also organizes visits to the neighboring villages and aware the farmers and people about medicinal plants and their conservation.
- Institution's NSS camp was organized between 3rd January to 9th January 2023 in Ekrukhe. On 3rd January 2023, the NSS camp organized a lecture on "Medicinal Tree Plantation: Importance, Conservation, and Applications" by Dr. V.S. Patil from the Department of Botany, to create awareness among students and villagers about the importance of medicinal tree plantations, their conservation, and applications in daily life to maintain sustainable health.
- To showcase the importance of medicinal plants, promote awareness, and encourage their use in healthcare institution has organized "Medicinal Plants Exhibition" in *Nighoj* on 23 September 2022, in which 23 students from botany department participated. The event successfully reached out to 145 villagers, educating them about the benefits and uses of medicinal plants. The exhibition and awareness programs inspired the local community to adopt medicinal plants for healthcare purposes, promoting a healthier and more sustainable lifestyle. The institution's efforts contributed to the preservation and promotion of traditional knowledge about medicinal plants.
- The *Swarajya Mahotsav-2022* organized between 11 and 12 August 2022 in *Ekrukhe, Khadkewake Sakuri* and *Pimplas* was a successful initiative by the Department of Botany to empower villagers with the knowledge and resources to maintain their health and wellbeing through the use of medicinal plants. In which, 18 students from the Department distributed 200 medicinal plant saplings among villagers for plantation.
- The institution has organized visit to the neighboring village *Khadkewake* in the month of July and August 2023 and aware the farmers and local peoples about medicinal plants and their conservation. About 200 Saplings of the medicinal plants were distributed to 40 farmers for plantation.

- *Vanmahotsav- 2022* was organized between 7 and 8 January 2022, under which around 500 saplings were planted in the villages of *Pimplas, Sakuri, Kelwad, Khadakewake and Ekrukhe*. These 500 samplings have been adopted by 500 families through *Gram panchayats* of respective villages. The traditional knowledge of medicinal plants was popularized among the students and their relatives through informative booklet "*Aajibaicha Batva*". The booklet contains Scientific and precise information regarding common and widely accessible therapeutic herbs.
- The institution in collaboration with the Regional Cum Facilitation Centre Western-Region (National Medicinal Plant Board, Ministry of AYUSH, Government of India), Department of Botany SPPU, Pune, has hosted the program *Aayush Aapke Dwar* under *Azadi ka Amrit Mahotsav* of distributing medicinal plants among the farmers on 3rd September 2021, under which about 550 medicinal plants were distributed to about 137 farmers.
- Our Institute is located on a vast, 21-acre campus, where many trees have been grown to provide the college with a lush canopy. In addition to having an eco-friendly campus, our institute successfully planted new saplings of about 80 herbs in our herbal garden for the finest practices for cultivating and maintaining a garden of medicinal plants for students and nearby farmers.
- To promote reforestation and conservation through seed ball cultivation and dispersal, the institution had organized seed ball activity on 20th July 2021 at *Adgaon* in which 04 staff members and 13 students from the department were participated.

Evidence of Success:

The success of implementing best practices in an herbal garden can be measured through various indicators, such as:

- ✓ Farmers planted medicinal plants in the vicinity of their houses, due to awareness programs.
- ✓ Institute successfully planted new saplings of about 80 herbs in our herbal garden for the finest practices for cultivating and maintaining a garden of medicinal plants for students and nearby farmers.
- ✓ Increase in awareness about medicinal plants among rural community members.
- ✓ The community is using *Tinospora cordifolia* (Gulvel) as immunity booster, *Justicia adhatoda* (Adulsa) leaves are used to control cough and throat infections. *Phyllanthus emblica* (Amla) is consumed which provides vitamin c, the boiled extract of Lemon grass, Ginger, Ocimum and Jaggery is used as an antipyretic.

Problems Encountered and Resources Required:

While implementing best practices in an herbal garden, some common challenges may arise, including:

- ✓ Limited availability of certain plant species like *Haritaki*, *Guduchi*, *Vasa*, *Sarpagandha* etc.
- ✓ Cultural and traditional beliefs conflicting with modern medicine.
- ✓ Engaging and involving local communities.

To overcome these challenges, the following resources are required:

- ✓ Expertise in horticulture and herbal medicine.
- ✓ Access to a wide variety of medicinal plant species.

“Survey of medicinal tree plantation by villagers near their households”

Report


Department of Botany of Arts, Science, and Commerce College, Rahata organized “ Survey of medicinal tree plantation by villagers near households” between 21st to 26th April 2023 in Khadkewake, Pimplas, Sakuri, Ekrukhe and Astagaon. The main objective behind the survey was to verify the development of positive mindset among the villagers about the importance of medicinal plants in maintaining sustainable health care.

As a result of various awareness campaign's ,medicinal plant sapling plantation and distribution drives organized by department of Botany remarkable effects had been observed. A total of 100 households were surveyed across the five villages and 45% of households had medicinal trees planted near their houses. The most common medicinal trees found were Tulsi, Aloe-vera, Neem, and Amla, villagers use these trees for various purposes, including healthcare, cooking, and religious rituals. The survey revealed a strong correlation between the institution's faculty programs and the villagers' motivation to plant medicinal trees.

The survey highlights the success of the institution's faculty programs in inspiring villagers to plant medicinal trees. The findings will help the department to develop future programs and activities that promote medicinal tree plantations and support sustainable healthcare practices in rural areas. A total of 17 students and 4 staff members from department of Botany under the guidance of Prof. S. V. Lahare, Head department of Botany, took efforts to carry out this survey.





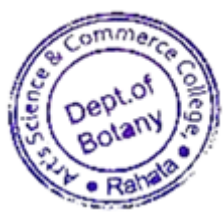


Medicinal saplings planted by villagers of Sakuri near their households



Report



During this period various kinds of lectures were organized by the college for NSS Volunteer and also for the villagers for awareness to the different aspects. Department of botany was also participated in this awareness activity. Dr. V.S. Patil, Assistant professor, Department of botany delivered a lecture on “conservation and plantation of medicinal plants” to aware the students and villagers about the value of medicinal plants in their life.

She explained that medicinal plant is any plant which, in one or more of its organs, contains substances that can be used for therapeutic purposes or for the synthesis of useful drugs. She also stated that number of plants have been used in traditional medicine for many years. Some do seem to work although there may not be sufficient scientific data to confirm their efficacy. Such plants should qualify as medicinal plants. She also talks about the various kinds of medicinal plants which can be easily available in our household and their use to cure some infections. In short she gave the information about the different home remedies to cure the common infections and illness like cold, fever, constipation, cough, acidity etc.

Later on she talked about the conservation of these plants by planting those plants at their nearby area. Dr. M. N. Kharde, Director, SSRI, Dr. S. S. Gholap, Principal, A. S. C. College, Rahata, Prof. S. V. Lahare, Vice principal and HOD, botany department, Miss. R. D. Desai, Dr. S. R. Potdar, Dr. R. D. Kasar, Dr. R. N. Wakchaure were also present on this occasion.

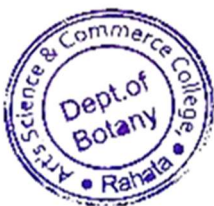
REPORT


The Department of Botany initiated a program to distribute medicinal plants in various people as part of our promise to promoting environmental awareness and the significance of herbal remedies for health and wellness.

Report

An herbal garden is established by Department of Botany in the college campus. These plants are provided to farmers, who use them as hosts on their farmlands. The garden was inaugurated by Hon'ble Shri. Radhakrushna Vikhe Patil, MLA and Ex-Minister, Govt. of Maharashtra. Dr. Arun Gurav- Assistant Director Incharge, Regional Ayurveda Research Institute, Ministry of AYUSH, Govt. of India, the institution successfully inaugurated an herbal garden on 3rd September 2021. The herbal garden dedicated to cultivating a variety of medicinal plants. This initiative aimed to promote the use of natural remedies, educate students on the importance of medicinal plants, and contribute to the conservation of valuable plant species. 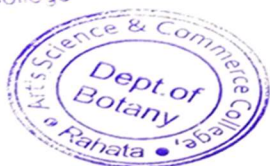

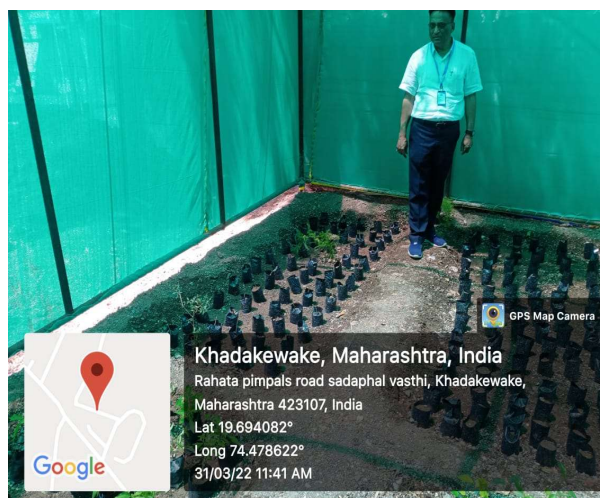

Report on

“Seed Ball Activity”

On 20th July 2021, the department of Botany organized a Seed Ball Activity at Adgaon Village, involving the participation of Second Year B.Sc. (S.Y. B.Sc.) students and staff members. This initiative aimed to promote reforestation, enhance biodiversity, and raise environmental awareness among the local community and students.

The native tree species like *African tulip* (flame of the forest), *Bauhinia variegata* (Kanchan), *Azadirachta indica* (Neem) etc. were selected for seed ball preparation to ensure compatibility with the local ecosystem. Areas in Adgaon Village that required reforestation were identified and marked. Participants travelled to Adgaon Village and dispersed the seed balls in the pre-selected areas. The seed balls were sown by scattering them across the targeted locations.

Approximately 100 seed balls were sown, which are expected to grow into healthy trees and plants, increasing the green cover in Adgaon Village. The introduction of plant species is expected to improve the local biodiversity, providing habitats for various wildlife species.

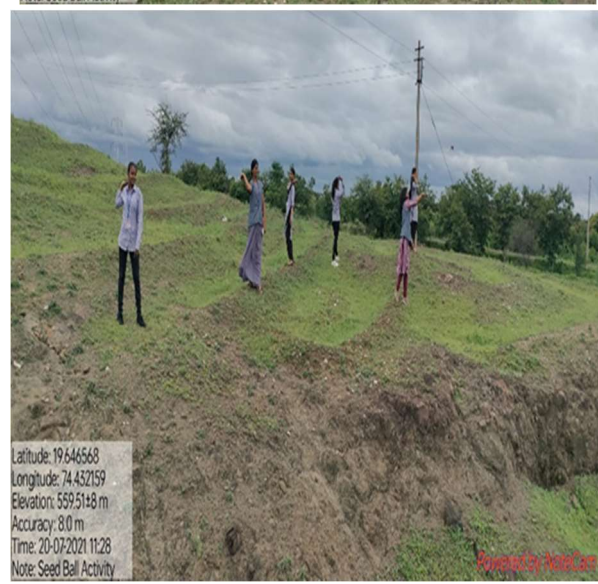
The excited participation of S.Y. B.Sc. students and staff members, along with the support of the local community, made this initiative successful and impactful.

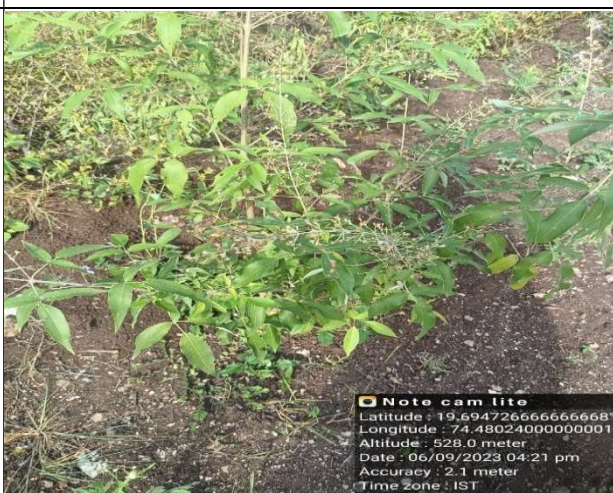

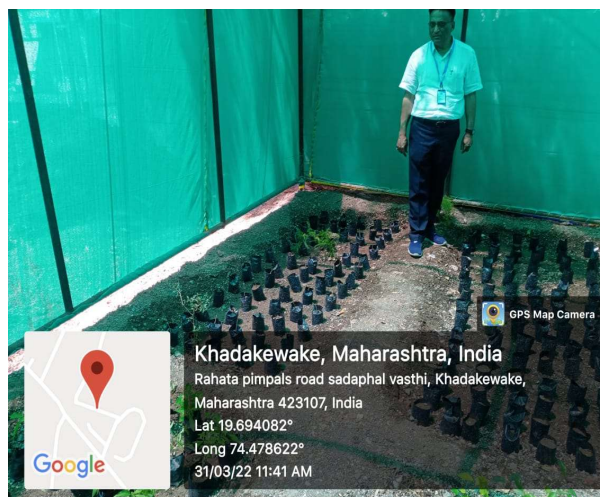
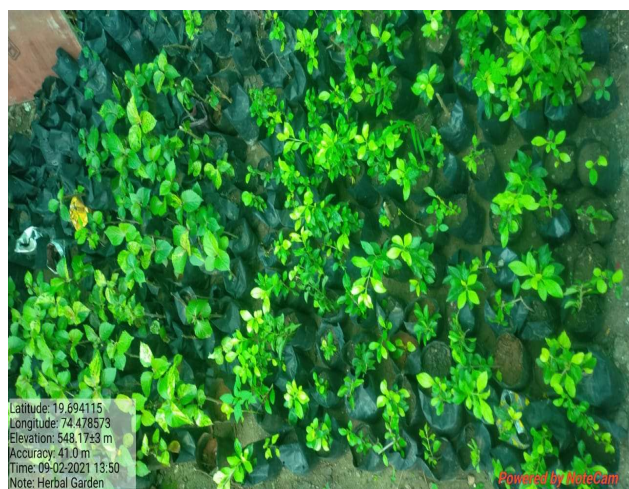
