
The Department of Botany is committed to fostering a sense of environmental responsibility and plans to organize similar events in the future to continue the noble cause of tree plantation and environmental conservation.






Solar Energy Popularization Program-2021-22



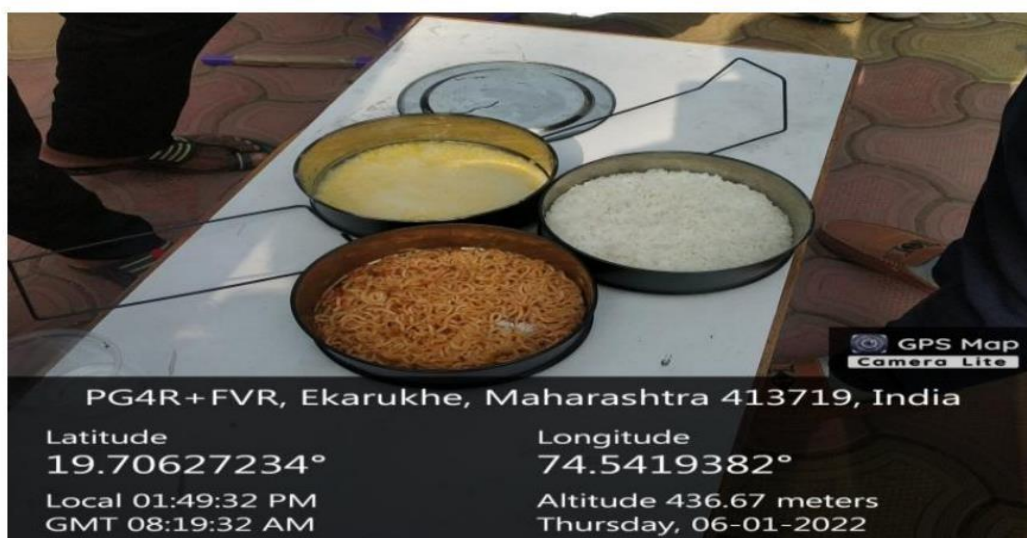

On 20th July 2021, the department of Botany organized a Seed Ball Activity at Adgaon Village, involving the participation of Second Year B.Sc. (S.Y. B.Sc.) students and staff members. This initiative aimed to promote reforestation, enhance biodiversity, and raise environmental awareness among the local community and students.

The native tree species like *African tulip* (flame of the forest), *Bauhinia variegata* (Kanchan), *Azadirachta indica* (Neem) etc. were selected for seed ball preparation to ensure compatibility with the local ecosystem. 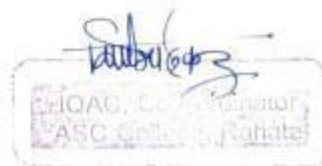
Socio- Economic Survey slum area in Rahata city


Report






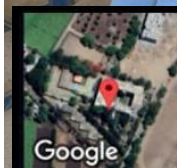
